A need to sync your data between devices? You have been misinformed!

Do not synchronize, just access. Even if offline.

Access, not synchronize!

- Use a **file system** featuring:
 - a global name space: the same path to the same file on all computers in the world (the web does not have a monopoly on this!)
 - persistent and consistent caching
 - built-in protection and flexible ACLs
 - server replication
 - disconnected operation (!)


Sounds to good to be feasible?

- Conceived >20 years ago at Carnegie-Mellon University, Pittsburgh, USA
- Supported in mainline Linux kernel since last millenium
- Has a global name space since 2002
- But still hardly known!
